

CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE SPORTS PROGRAM

- **PARENTS RELEASE:** In consideration for your accepting this entry, I do hereby for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and discharge forever any and all rights and claims for damages which hereafter accrue to me, against St. Patricia Athletic Association, their Respective agents, officers, representatives, successors, and or assigns, for any and all damages which may be sustained and suffered by me or my child in connection with and or arising out of my traveling to or participating in, and returning from said athletic meet except as covered by insurance subscribed for whenever possible, insurance claims should be sent to your own insurance company. Use our insurance to cover deductibles and any other cost not covered under your own insurance.
- A parent/guardian must attend a meeting with the coach and review the policies to participate in the program and agree to adhere to these policies and mission of the St. Patricia Athletic Association.
- Parent/Guardian must complete all the required Registration Forms and SPAA Medical Release and Emergency Form and be PAID IN FULL before a child will be allowed to participate in any program.
- All applicants must attend St. Patricia school or be registered and an active participant with the St. Patricia Religious Ed program.
- Parent/Guardian Responsibility: Parents are responsible for transportation to and from the point of all events and practices in a prompt manner.
- Parental Confirmation: The parents confirm that the child is fully eligible to participate in the activity and is in good standing at St. Patricia School or is a registered and active participant with the St. Patricia Religious Ed program and is without any medical or physical limitation not hereto disclosed.
- Basketball and Volleyball teams may split if the number reaches 16. In 4th and 5th Grades, the team is split into equal teams. In 6th through 8th Grades, the split is done based on skill. No refunds will be given once evaluations have begun. If evaluations are not required for a team, then refunds will not be given once the first practice has begun OR a confirmation of your child being placed on a team has been confirmed by the Coach / Director.
- The St. Patricia Athletic Association expects a level of commitment from the parent/athlete. If your child is in other activities/programs that may interfere with your child attending all practices and more importantly games, please let us know.
- Every parent/guardian is expected to work their concession duty. If you fail to show for your assigned time, your \$100.00 concession check will be cashed.
